St Mary's Dedication

THE CENTENARY booklet from 1965 gives a fascinating list of furniture and fixtures and who donated them. Pride of place among the benefactors of 100 years earlier were Canon Luck who donated the Priest's House, Charles John Eyston who donated the Church, the Caretaker's Cottage, the Bridge, the High Altar, the Benches, the North East window of the Sanctuary, the Patronal Statue of the Blessed Virgin, the Old School, Endowments for the Church and the School, and a Processional Cross and Thurible no longer needed at St Amand's Chapel, Hendred House. Many other features of the Church were donated by the Eyston family, but it was interesting to hear in the last couple of years from descendants of Rachel Hunt, who gave the Pulpit, and the South East window of the Nave.

More than 100 years on – back in 1965 – fundraising was apparently no longer necessary. The buildings were complete and the latest addition – new buildings for St Amand's School – had been completed a couple of years earlier, with much enjoyable fund-raising including a donkey derby. In 1965 they decided, therefore, to raise money to train a priest. The cost for this, in those days, was said to be $\pounds 2,000$. Nowadays it costs about $\pounds 25,000$ per year - $\pounds 150,000$ in total.

At our 150th Anniversary (2015), the priorities were modernising our backstage facilities – providing a kitchen and loo and refurbishing the 1865 Sacristy and what is now the Holy Family Room for meetings and children's liturgy. Though we need to complete work on the font area – bringing together the aumbry (cupboard for holy oils) and font – we have installed a proper cover. Our attention is now turning to the St Mary's Parish Rooms, badly in need of a facelift. We hope that, in future years, the parish will look back in gratitude to us for what we have managed to do in our generation to maintain the gifts of which we are stewards.

And what of the future? We can certainly foresee that, in addition to running repairs, we shall eventually need a new floor, with underfloor heating that warms rather than blows noisily. The life of an electronic organ is on average 15 years so our rather extraordinary instrument is in its dotage. And who knows what else will be needed? *Fr Andrew*
