St Louis de Montfort's Way: Total Consecration

LED BY the Shrine of Our Lady Walsingham, we began a pilgrimage on 21st February towards the re-consecration of England as the Dowry of Our Lady. Part of the Walsingham spirituality is that, once this country learns to look once more to Jesus through Mary, we shall once again be a Catholic land. Needless to say, it all begins with personal conversion and a deepening in personal holiness. The significance of the 33 days of preparation – one for each year of Our Lord's life on earth – is that the devotions many will follow are St Louis de Montford's schedule of exercises. St Luis de Montfort (1673-1716) was a Parisian priest, a gifted preacher, who came to be remembered most for his devotion to Mary.

St Louis de Montfort's method of devotion is known as 'Total Consecration'. He divides the 33 days into sections, each section having its own prayers, and each day its own reading. First comes 12 days of preparation in which we pray the *Veni Creator*, the *Ave Maris Stella*, the *Magnificat*, and the 'Glory be'. Then follow three weeks, each week having a specific focus. The first is about humility and we pray the Litany of the Holy Ghost, the Litany of Loreto, and the *Ave Maris Stella* to help us. During the second week, we ask for better understanding and we add the prayer to Mary by St Louis-Marie, and five decades of the Rosary. During the third week, we seek to better understand Christ through meditation and add the Litany of the Holy Name of Jesus, Montfort's prayer to Jesus, and the prayer 'O Jesus Living in Mary'. The 34th day, the Annunciation, is the day of consecration.

However much use we make of St Louis-Marie's spiritual exercises, we join in praying for the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, for the deepening of our own pilgrimage and the reconsecration of this nation as the Dowry of Mary.
