## THE 'O' ANTIPHONS

The end of Advent brings increased urgency of prayer to the Son of God, that He might 'Come and save us'. The final seven days are marked by special antiphons at the Magnificat at Vespers, each beginning 'O' and each invoking the Saviour by a different prophetic title. Reversed, the initials form the acrostic "ERO CRAS", 'tomorrow, I will be." The day after the final antiphon is: Christmas Day. A count-down-to-Christmas, if you like, drawn from sacred Scripture, reminding us that what we await at Christmas is not presents, or turkey, neither rows nor indigestion, but Jesus. Why not pray these each day as the Sacred Time approaches?

## O SAPIENTIA | O WISDOM

O Wisdom, proceeding from the mouth of the Most High, pervading and permeating all creation, mightily ordering all things: Come and teach us the way of prudence.
